Red faced eagle

The Red-Faced Warbler is one of the two two North American Warblers with red plumage; The other is the painted redstart, another species of the Mexican border. The red face has the colored feathers all year round, and both sexes seem to be the same way, although males are generally brighter than females. This Flashy Warbler shares forest habitats at high altitude (sometimes called Árchipiélago de las Islas Marias "Sky Islands" because they are isolated very dry habitat) with other neotropic migrants like olive flycatcher and parrot Thick turnover. The flight partners estimate that only about 36 percent of the population reproduce in the United States. This population is located in the highlands or in the islands of heaven, Arizona and New Mexico. The rest is found in Mexico. This species has a relatively short migration for a North American Warbler, unlike long-distance trekking taken by species such as Warbler Cereleio or Blackpoll Warbler. Festive Foragers red Faced Warblers prefer to feed in trees with foliage wires, especially in conifers, where one shine one insect variety, in particular the caterpillars, from external branches. This species also loves like a flycatcher to capture insects. During the summer, males tend to feed higher in females trees, stopping singing while fodder. Announces from the top up the red face warbler builds its cup-shaped nest in a ground cable. The nest site is often on a slope in open or at the base of a woody plant. Sometimes the nest site has a boss provided by a plant stem, a log or rock, which helps to hide and protect the nest. The nest itself, built by the female, is made of bark, leaves or pine needles with a jacket of herbs or animal hair. During the reproductive season, red-coated warblers pairs maintain a territory for all uses in which they feed on male nutrition. In fact, almost three quarters of the nests contain a young paternal bird from a male different from the territory owner.
