- ❖ Большинство существительных, оканчивающихся на **-fi, -fe** образуют множественное число путем изменения **f** на **v** и добавления окончания **-es**

- ❖ Некоторые существительные образуют множественное число без добавления окончаний -s или -es. Например:

Singular	Translation	Plural

The **Future Simple Tense** is often called **will**, because we make the future simple tense with the modal auxiliary **will**. For negative sentences in the future simple tense, we insert **not** between the auxiliary verb and main verb. For question sentences, we exchange the **subject** and **auxiliary verb**. When we use the future simple tense in speaking, we often contract the subject and auxiliary verb. For negative sentences in the future simple tense, we contract with **won't**.

Future Simple образуется при помощи вспомогательных глаголов **shall** (в первом лице единственного и множественного числа) и **will** – во втором и третьем лице. В американском варианте языка употребляется **will** во всех лицах. В современном британском языке в 1-м лице допустимо употреблять как **shall**, так и **will**. Чаще они не различимы, так как в речи и на письме сокр. до **'ll**.

Чтобы образовать **вопросительную** форму, вспомогательные глаголы **shall/ will** ставят перед подлежащим:

Will I see you tomorrow?	Увижу ли я вас завтра?
Will you go for a walk?	Ты пойдешь на прогулку?
- Yes, I'll go for a walk.	- Да. Я пойду на прогулку.
What shall we do tomorrow?	Что мы будем делать завтра?

Will в вопросе с **you** может означать вежливую просьбу:

Will you please open the window? Откройте, пожалуйста, окно.

Отрицательная форма строится так:

I shall/will not do this.	Я не сделаю этого.
You will not (won't) be late.	Ты не опоздаешь.
